Dear constituent,

It has been a busy few months since I last updated you.

Here in Calgary I have had the chance to meet with countless residents, community groups, and local businesses to hear about how decisions being made in Ottawa are impacting our local community.

In Ottawa, I have been busy standing up for Calgarians against a Liberal government that seems to grow more out of touch with the concerns of Albertan families by the day. Getting Results for Constituents!

Nearly 4 years ago, a Calgary Shepard resident, Tim, asked for my help getting an unfair technical rule in Canada's vehicle importation laws changed. After years of unanswered requests and letters to Liberal ministers and government officials, I convinced Parliament's transport committee to agree to a short study on the issue. Following the study, the government has committed to making the requested changes to the importation laws this year.


