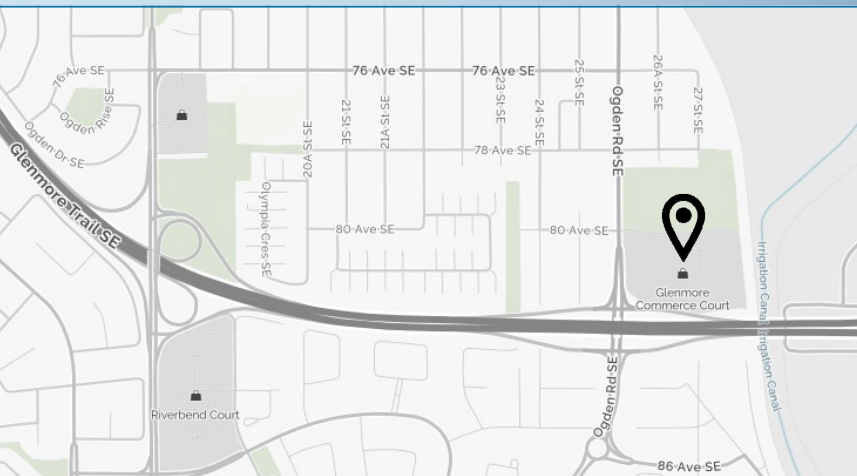


## Are you better off?
